I am again asking for this updated information so our records can be current.** Please mail, email or drop off at the village office the information that we need if you want to be alerted of any emergency that may affect the village. # **Message from Parking Enforcement**

According to the zoning laws, no ungaraged, unlicensed, unregistered, motor vehicle (including but not limited to an automobile, motorcycle, dirt bike, all-terrain vehicle, boat or boat trailer) or snowmobile may be parked, located, or stored on a residential lot in excess of 30 days or located in a front yard of a residential lot or on Village property for more than 24 hours. Any vehicle or snowmobile parked located, or stored in violation of this section may be towed and stored by the request of the Village at the owner's expense without notice. I want to give all of those affected by this zoning ordinance time to come into compliance and will not start ticketing or towing such vehicles for one month. Thank you for your cooperation.

In addition a committee on parking has been formed by the Village Board. I will keep you informed of any proposals or potential changes.
