Local Law No. 5 of the year 2021

A local law amending tax billing dates and water and sewer billing dates.

Be it enacted by the Village Board of the

County

City

Town

Village Round Lake as follows:

Section I. Substantive Law: Article II to Chapter 162 is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following, entitled “Village Tax Bills; Water Rents and Sewer Rents”, which shall read in its entirety:

§ 162-15 Frequency of charges.

- A. Village taxes shall be levied and mailed once each year on June 1 or the first business day thereafter.
- B. Village water rents and sewer fees shall be levied and mailed twice per year on June 1 or the first business day thereafter and on December 1 or the first business day thereafter.

§ 162-16 Billing rates and penalties.

- A. Village taxes shall be paid at a rate of 100% if paid in June; 105% if paid in July; 106.5% if paid in August; 108% if paid in September, September 30th being the last day of collection.
- B. Village water rents and sewer fees levied in June shall be paid at a rate of 100% if paid in June; 105% if paid in July; 106.5% if paid in August; 108% if paid in September; and 109.5% if paid by October 31st, being the last day of collection.
- C. Village water rents and sewer fees due in December shall be paid at a rate of 100% if paid in December; 105% if paid after the first business day in January; 106.5% if paid in February; 108% if paid in March; and 109.5% if paid by April 30th, being the last day of collection.

- D. Village taxes not paid by September 30th shall be relieved to the county for enforcement pursuant to the authority granted in Article III of this chapter.
- E. Village water rents and sewer fees levied in June which are not paid by October 31st shall be added to the December Village water rent and sewer fee bill. Payments made after the first business day in January shall be paid at a rate of 105%; 106.5% if paid in February; 108% if paid in March; and 109.5% if paid in April.
- F. Village water rents and sewer fees levied in December which are not paid by April 30th shall be relieved and added to the June Village property tax bill shall be paid at a rate of 100% if paid in June; 105% if paid in July; 106.5% if paid in August; and 108% if paid in September.

Section II. Supersession: This local law is hereby adopted pursuant to the provision of §10 of the New York State Municipal Home Rule Law and §10 of the New York State Statue of Local Governments, it being the intent of the Village Board of Trustees to supersede any and all contrary or inconsistent State Laws.

Section III. Inconsistency: All other local laws and ordinances of the Village of Round Lake, if any, that are inconsistent with the provisions of this local law are hereby repealed: provided, however, that such repeal shall only be to the extent of such inconsistency and in all other respects this local law shall be in addition to such other local laws or ordinances, if any, regulating and governing the subject matter covered by this local law.

Section IV. Savings Clause: If any clause, sentence, paragraph, word, section or part of this local law shall be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such judgment, order and/or decision shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation of the clause, sentence, paragraph, worked section or part thereof directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment shall have been rendered.

Section V. Effective Date: This local law shall take place immediately upon its filing with the New York State Secretary of State.
